## Guidelines for checking students' 3G documents for entry to classes

### (1) Background information

Winter semester 2021/22 will be offering in-person courses following three semesters of online teaching. This was agreed by the Berlin State Conference of Rectors and Presidents and the TU Berlin Crisis Committee. In addition to minimum distancing of 1.5 meters, students may only participate in in-person courses if they are fully vaccinated, have recovered from the coronavirus, or have a negative test result (3 Gs).

### (2) What kind of proof of vaccination is accepted?

To gain entry, students must present one of the following forms of documentation. No other documentation is accepted:

- 1.) "TU Berlin WiSe 2021/2022" vaccination sticker on the student ID
- 2.) TU proof of vaccination including sticker

### (3) When is a person considered **recovered** and what kind of proof is required?

Students who have recovered from a coronavirus infection must present confirmation from a doctor. A person is considered recovered if they have a positive PCR test that is at least 28 days old, but not older than 180 days.

The following result formats are accepted:

- Digital result in the CoronaWarnApp or CovPass App
- PCR result issued by a laboratory
- PCR result issued by a doctor
- PCR result issued by testing center
- Medical note (must state a PCR test was taken and when)

**Please make sure documentation includes the individual's first and last name as well as date of birth and matches the holder's personal ID.**

**A TU sticker is not available for students with "recovered" status.**

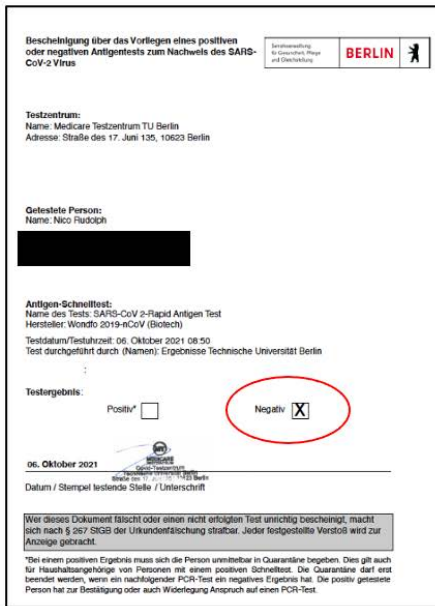
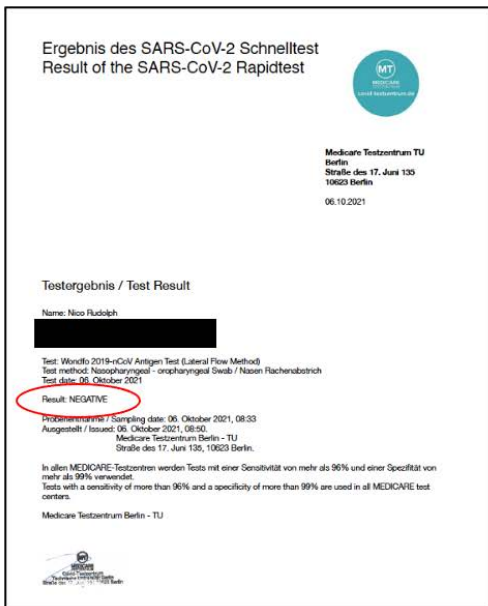
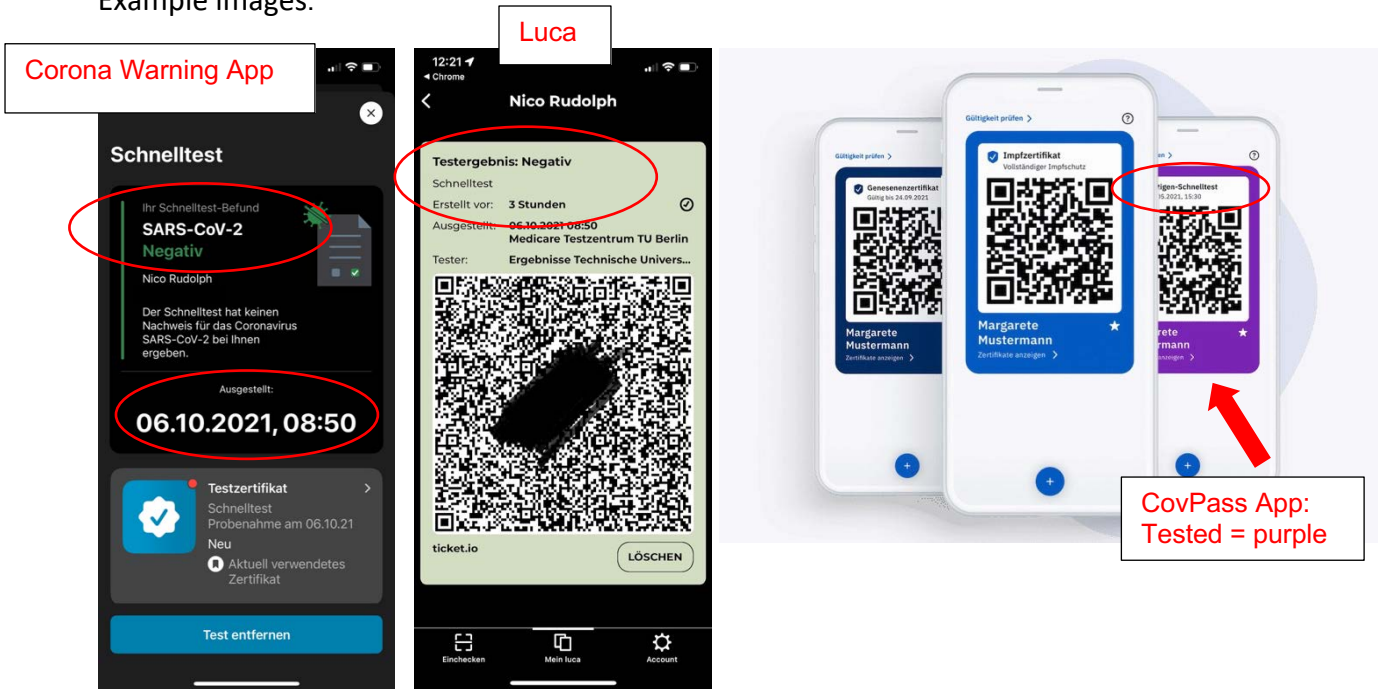
**(4) What kind of negative test and proof are required?**

Students who wish to present a negative test result to attend class must have a negative antigen rapid test no older than 48 hours. Self-tests are not accepted.

The following result formats are accepted:

- Digital result (e.g. in the CoronaWarnApp or Luca)
- Result issued by a laboratory
- Result issued by a doctor
- Result issued by a testing center (e.g. a pharmacy)
- Medical note (must include the type of test and date the test was taken)

Date and time sample was taken may not be older than 48 hours.

## **(5) Guidelines**

Pursuant to the current coronavirus regulations of the State of Berlin, TU Berlin is required to confirm students have proof of one of the 3Gs. This task has been assigned to security staff for courses exceeding 40 participants and to instructors for courses with up to 40 participants. As such, security staff and instructors are authorized to check students' documents and, if necessary, request personal ID or similar documents.

Students who are unable to present proper documentation of one of the 3Gs cannot participate in the course and will not be granted entry to the classroom. Proof of one of the 3Gs is not required to enter TU buildings. As such, students may remain in the building as long as they adhere to the other hygiene regulations.

Please request your students to arrive on time to the first class so that you can hold class without interruptions. Please be aware that security staff will only check documents for larger classes at the beginning of class and will then move on to another class.

## **(6) Supplemental information about hygiene**

In addition to this 3G rule, it is important to continue to air out rooms. All rooms without automatic ventilation systems are to be thoroughly and frequently aired. We recommend opening windows fully every 15 minutes.
