This position is integrated in the Chair of Macroeconomics at TU Berlin, starting from as early as possible for a period of 5 years.

Working field:

Research on topics of macroeconomics and/or financial crises, for example: transmission channels of monetary policy, rationing equilibria and price adjustment processes, climate-neutral growth, consequences of strategic uncertainty, causes and prevention of asset price bubbles. Methods of analyses: theory, simulation models, and/or laboratory experiments. Opportunity to do a habilitation or acquire an equivalent status of qualification for a full professorship. Teaching in macroeconomics and monetary economics, international economics, or financial crises with a teaching duty in accordance with the regulations in LVVO.
