STARTING POINT

Teaching in English is a challenge when it is not your first language. Teaching an international student group who are also mostly non-native English speakers is even more challenging. You want to give the best possible seminar or lecture to your audience, deliver contents in ex-cathedra teaching as informative and interesting as possible and you also want to create a learning environment where your students can actively participate in exercises and ask questions?

TARGET GROUP

Visiting scholars, international researchers and lecturers, who want to further develop their international and intercultural teaching competences and improve their individual teaching style. All non-native English and German teaching staff who are already teaching or supposed to teach in English.

CONTENTS

We give you an introduction to theoretical and practical didactic aspects of university teaching and learning, focusing on activating and innovative methods and media. In the advanced courses you can deepen and widen as well as specialize on certain aspects of good teaching according to your personal needs.

METHODS

In our interactive courses, we will use short lectures, demonstration, exercises, single tasks and group works, presentations, discussion and exchange of experiences as well as direct application and transfer to your daily teaching practice.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

We will work intensively with active learning processes and individual teaching practice and support you to improve your teaching competences and the quality of your teaching.

COMPETENCE DEVELOPMENT

Participants can improve subject area competences and skills (course planning and overall curriculum, students' future professional practice), pedagogical skills (course design, structuring student self-study activities, teaching courses, supervision of individual student work, assessment and student evaluation), organizational skills (teaching team, program committee, colleagues and student assistants), general skills (learning climate, language proficiency, effective communication, dealing with criticism and feedback).

CERTIFICATE

Participants will get a certificate of participation for each attended course with more than 80 % active performance in the course.

Participants can gain a cumulative certificate on all courses attended.

We recommend to attend all didactic basic courses and a choice of at least cumulated 24 hours of the didactic advanced courses. You are invited to a peer-to-peer observation in your lectures.

We also recommend that an individual teaching portfolio is compiled. Here we offer a 2 hours personal coaching on the basis of your written draft. On demand, a didactic expert observation of your lecture with feedback will be possible.
