The principle behind „Studieren ab 16“ is simple: It offers motivated high achievers (grades 10 and above) in Berlin and Brandenburg, who do not feel academically challenged or motivated in class, the chance to attend regular introductory courses at TU Berlin for one semester and earn credits in the meantime.

You can then apply these credits to your later studies at TU Berlin or another university.

Participation is free of charge and is possible in both the summer and winter semester.

The courses are all taught in German, so German language skills of at least level B2 are required for participation. Participation is free of charge and is possible in both the summer and winter semester. Unfortunately, participation for high school students from other German states or from German schools abroad is not possible.
