[EXIST Research Transfer](#) is BMWK funding for excellent high-tech start-up projects. The funding extends over two phases and aims to transfer scientific findings from the university into a start-up.

Dr Caroline Reid is an innovation manager with a focus on technology scouting at the Centre for Entrepreneurship at TU Berlin.
